

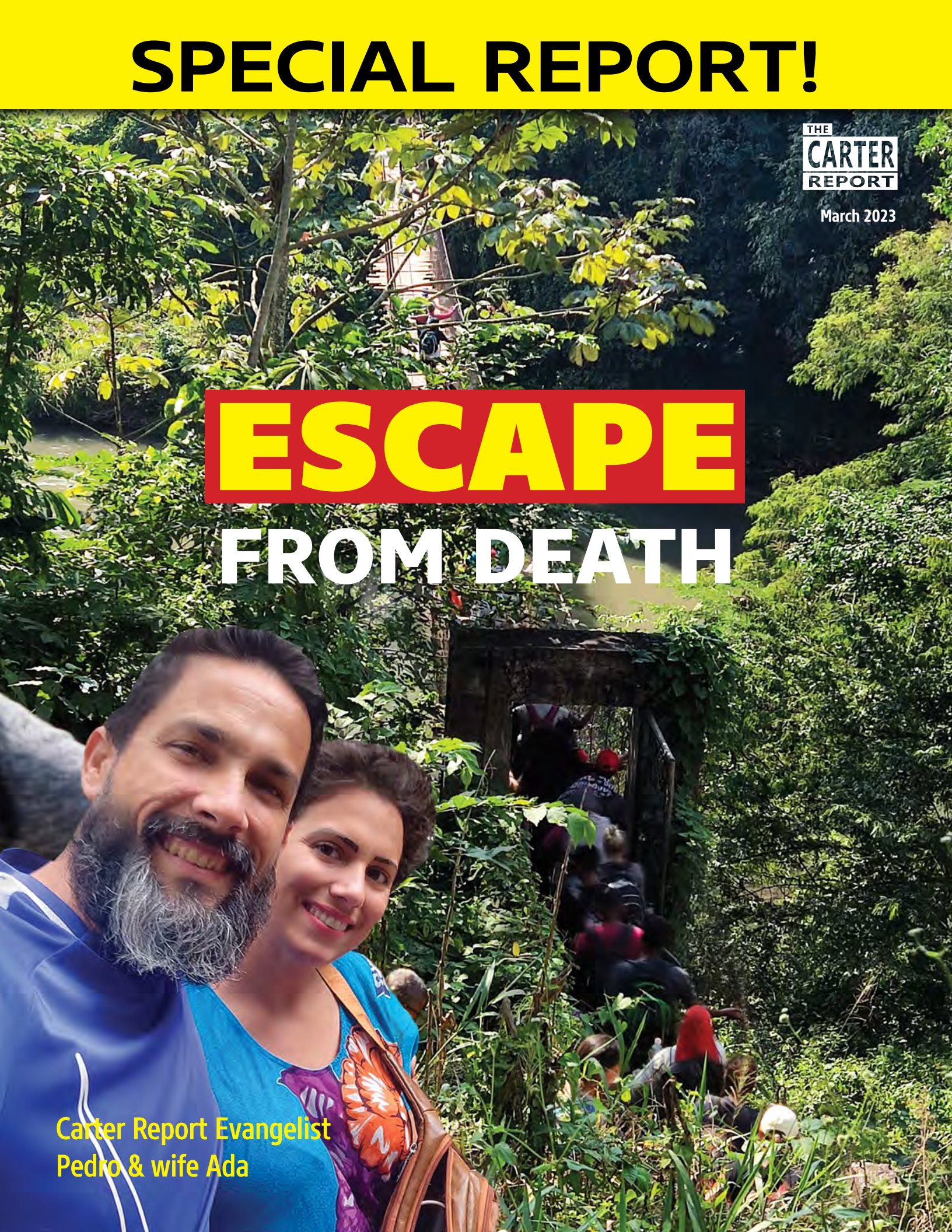

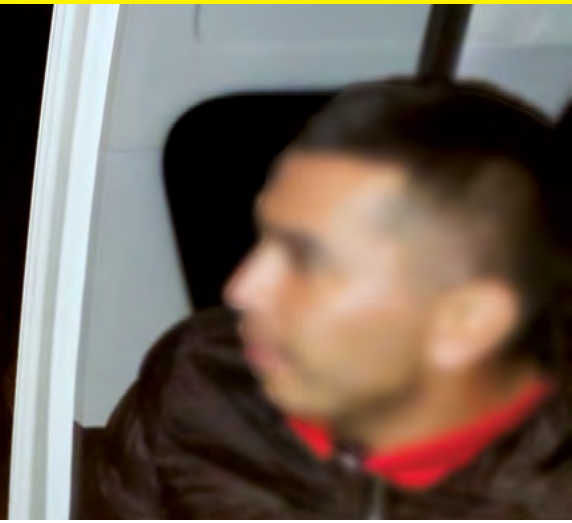

NINETEEN DAYS WHEN THEY SAW THE DEATHS OF FELLOW REFUGEES.

They were escorted by gang members. We sent the necessary funds along the way. There was no other way and we have no regrets. We paid for a service rendered. We would do it again. In a heartbeat.

They climbed a mountain range in Mexico that was over 10,000 feet high. That's over 3,000 meters. They shivered. They staggered. They stumbled. They got up and struggled on. Nightly they were herded with other refugees into dirty sheds. They were fed bits of fruit and fried potatoes. They slept on the cold earth. For **NINETEEN DAYS.** Their escorts were **GANG MEMBERS.**

One day, a new gang member asked the small weary group, *"Where is the pastor? We hear you have a pastor here. Where is he?"* Pedro confessed, *"I am the pastor."* He did not know what to expect. Perhaps he would be executed. The gang leader took him aside and whispered, *"Do not fear. We are your brothers. We will protect you."* Soon food arrived. It was their first real meal in **MORE** than a week.

Finally, Pedro and family arrived at the U.S. border. They were processed, given a shower, food and new clothes. They were in, but the journey was just beginning. They now need a work permit, permanent residency, a place to stay. *Will you help?*
